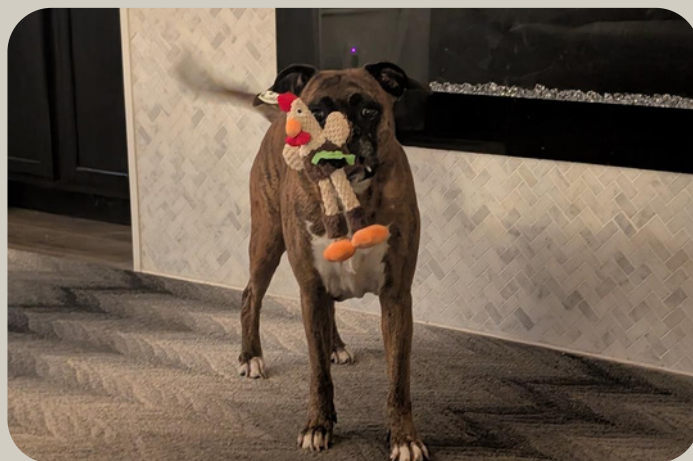


Pets

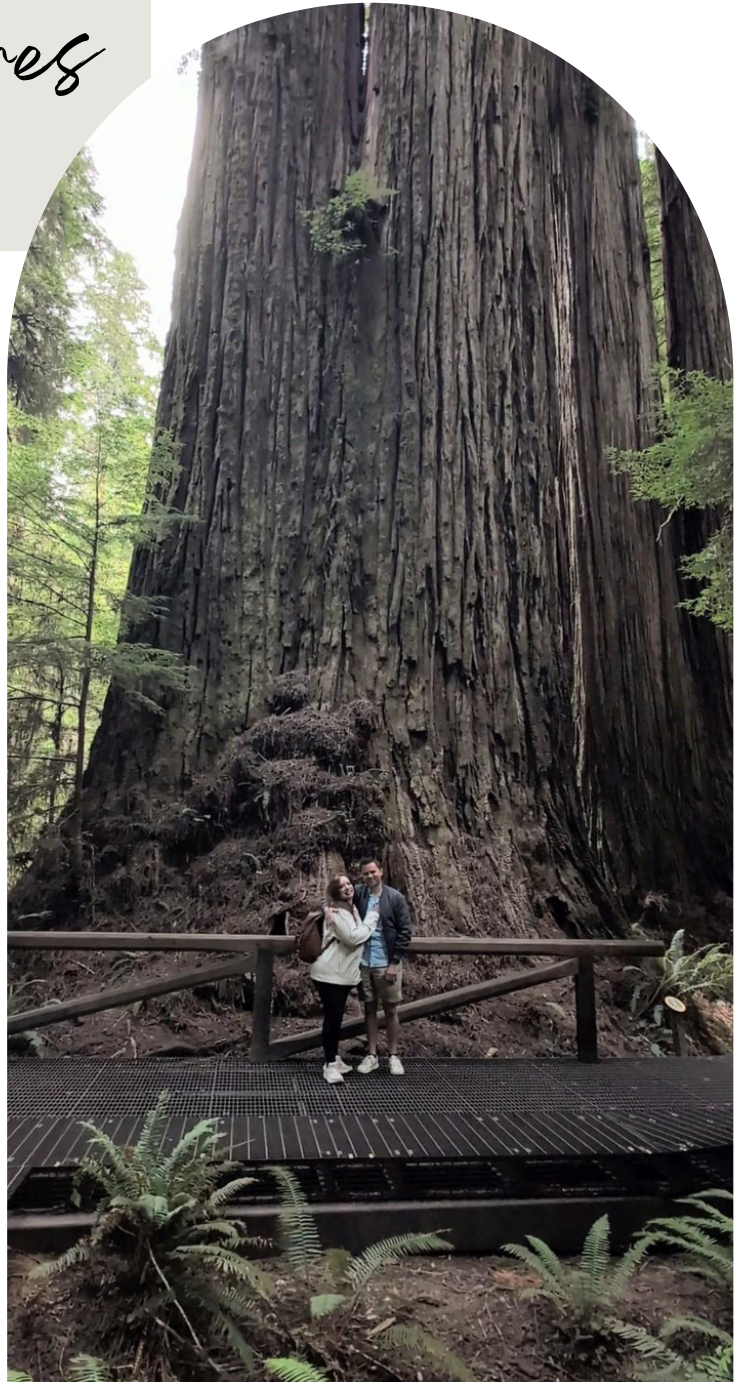

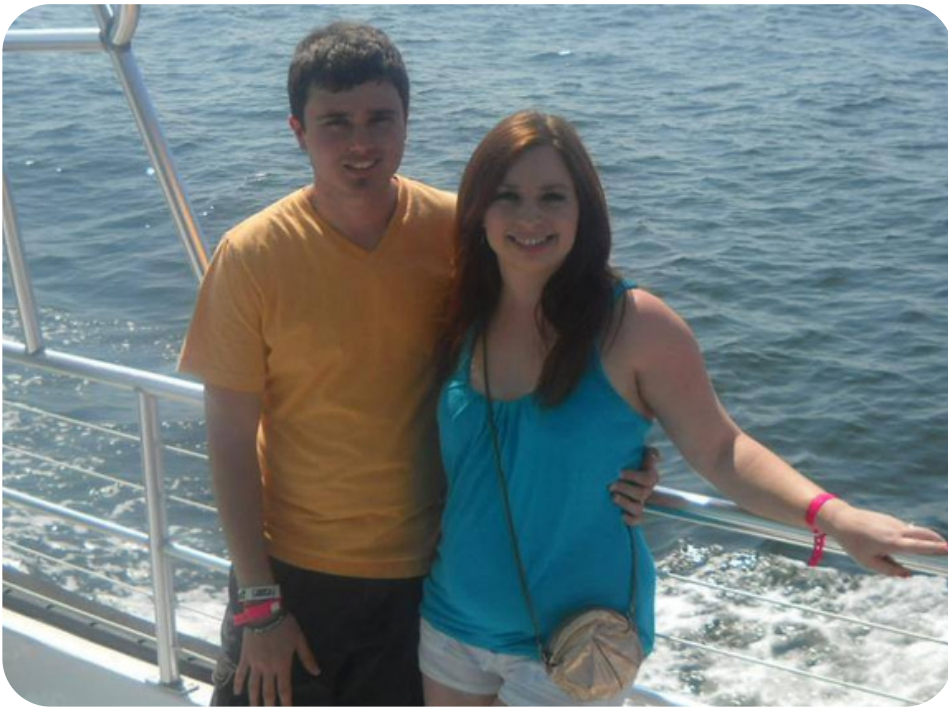

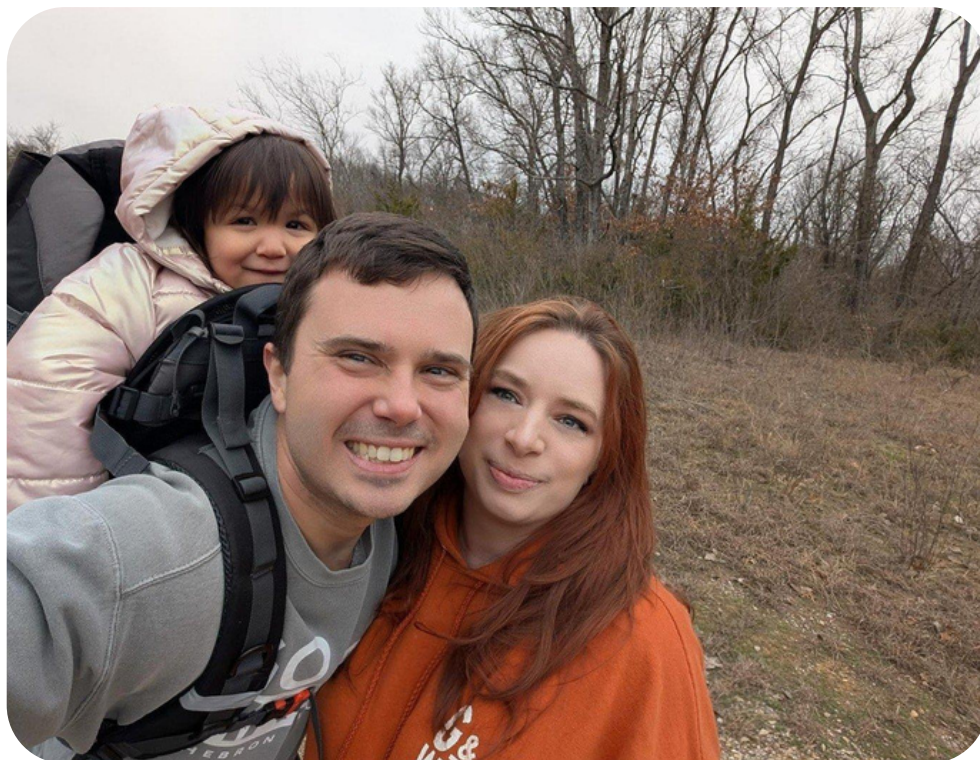
Dear Future Child,
